# • Promoting Congregational Vitality Work

The Vitality Survey is a 36-question survey that scores each question/topic as "high", "medium", and "at-risk." This free program helps congregations have conversations about vitality and goal-setting. The program also uses demographic information so that congregations can compare themselves to their surrounding community. Our goal is to visit congregations who have done the survey or are in the process to help support ongoing work.

# • Helping Synod new starts

San Jose Obrero is 10 years old. The new pastor started in July 2023. NIS is partnering with SE Iowa Synod to support this ministry in the Quad Cities which worships at Trinity Lutheran Church in Moline. They worship 30-40 people each Sunday.

A second new start, Becoming in Oswego, started in November. A part-time mission developer is having one-to-one meetings throughout the community. They are not yet worshiping.

Members of our committee will be helping to evaluate these ministries.

### • Helping congregations create outreach ministries

Some members of our committee were involved in presentations at CRE to provide churches with ideas to create and strengthen their outreach. We are also available for support and questions.
