

Our Congregations in Transition Updated February 24, 2025

FULL-TIME CALLS

In the Northern Illinois Synod, we currently have 21 full-time call vacancies (six of the "full-time" congregations are determining if they are part-time) and several additional congregations seeking part-time ministers.

RM= Rostered Minister (Pastor or Deacon)
MSP= Ministry Site Profile (Congregation's "resume")
RMP= Roster Minister Profile (Pastor or Deacon's "resume")

Congregations in a full-time call process or a traditional part-time call process journey through the following phases between settled calls of Roster Ministers:

PHASE ONE: RM announces departure/Placing Transition Leader in Congregation

PHASE TWO: Congregation/Council identifies Call Committee and congregation enters discernment

PHASE THREE: MSP is submitted and Call Committee Interviews Candidates

PHASE FOUR: Call Committee forwards name to Council for recommendation/Congregational vote

PHASE FIVE: Settled Minister is welcomed. Synod follows up in six months.

The Office of Bishop works with Congregations, Councils, and Call Committees during each phase of their transition. The congregation receives support to deepen their collective faith and specific activities to complete during their time of transition. We hope congregations experience times of transition as spiritual discernment and focus on what God is calling them to be and do as a community of faith.

Under Bishop's direction and in consultation with our synod partners in Region 5, congregations will be invited to explore how the gift of diversity can deepen their reflection as the Body of Christ. These conversations and learnings around diversity, equity, and belonging will be an invitational gift for congregations in transition.

PHASE THREE: MSP Activated/Interviewing Candidates for Call

1. Cross and Crown, Roscoe (vacant February 2024)
